Interstages provides opportunities for early adolescent girls in low-income neighborhoods to discover talents, strengthen and develop skills, and heighten self-awareness, setting the stage for a successful transition into young adulthood. To fulfill this mission, Interstages operates a daily afterschool youth development program for middle school girls (grades 6-8) in Wards 7-8. Interstages is a community-based organization that highly values community leadership.

Our Board of Directors is a small, working Board. Plans for 2010 include expanding Board membership, further defining our committee structure, and systematizing Board functions. In addition, we recently received a sustainability planning grant intended to engage the Board and staff in setting our organization up for success through the current recession and into the future. This work will involve ½-day to full-day retreats, as well as individual and small group work involving representatives of all Interstages' stakeholders. Board members should expect to contribute 5-10 hours per month.

Requirements for all Board Members:

- Commitment to Interstages' mission and values, as evidenced by regular participation in programs and events.
- Consistent attendance and informed participation in monthly Board meetings and committee work.
- Participation in fundraising efforts.
- Personal financial contributions at least annually.

The Treasurer will chair Interstages' Finance and Audit Committee and provide monthly financial reports to the full Board.

Additional requirements:

- Expertise in finance, incl. cash flow projection, budgeting, audit prep, internal financial controls, GAAP, IRS Form 990, other nonprofit financial management and reporting.
- Ability to communicate financial concepts to Board members and other stakeholders.
